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






FAQs

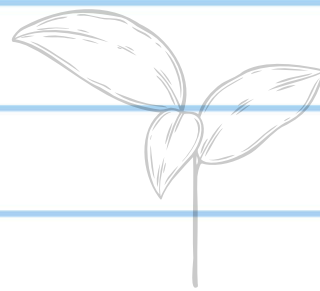
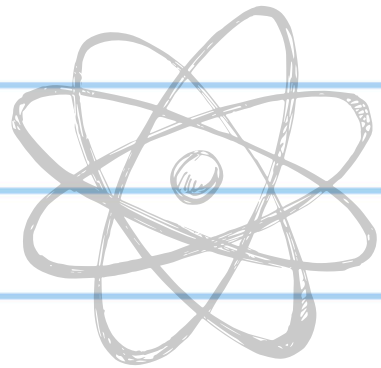


Yes! We read stories, have unstructured play time, art activities, and much more!



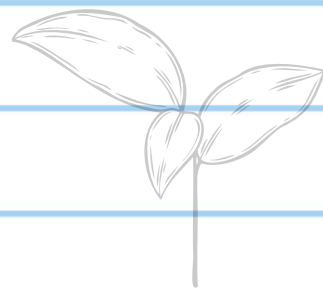
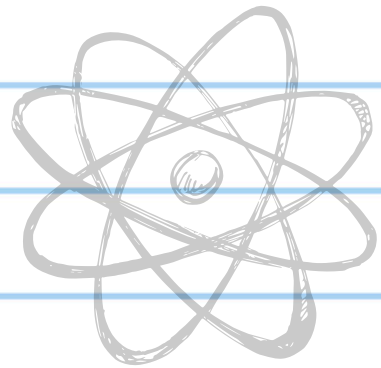

Do you still nap, even though it's Pre-K?




The two STEM rooms nap for 1 hour. All other rooms in our building nap for 2 hours.










How do you assess my child? Do you have parent/teacher conferences?



We assess your child in a variety of ways. We conduct monthly assessments in our STEM rooms to determine where your child is academically and adjust our teaching from there. We also use anecdotal notes to guide instruction so we can differentiate lessons with your child. We have conference twice a year, where we share your child's progress with you!
